Colours...... White, Black, Yellow, Blue, Red

Shelf life..... minimum 12 months (in cool, dry conditions)

Surface Preparation

- Remove loose dirt, dust, leaves, etc. with air blower or vacuum.
- Remove oil and grease with commercial alkaline detergent. Rinse thoroughly with water.
- Allow surface to dry completely before applying product.

Mixing recommendation

- Mix the entire contents of the can before decanting
- Stir thoroughly with a broad paddle or mechanical mixer to ensure even consistency of the product
- Supplied ready for use. May be thinned with Wagon Paints' T7 Thinner if necessary. Stir as above.

Chloromarc

Application

Spray apply using airless spray equipment

Small areas may be coated by brush (using T7 Thinner as reducer)

nozzle pressure......80 - 100 psi (550 - 690 KPa)

volume of thinner.....up to 10%

Addition of reflective beads Suitable at typical rates

NOTE: This product is suitable for application through most commercially available line- and road-marking equipment. Nozzle sizes, pressures, etc. will vary from machine to machine. The customer will need to adjust equipment variables to achieve optimum results.

Safety precautions

- Contents are flammable keep away from all ignition sources
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes when mixing, wear gloves and goggles
- When spraying, ensure adequate ventilation and wear appropriate protective clothing and equipment
